Motivation

Journalistic content

I will:



Not personal attacks but corrective

Christian Science theology motivated her giving her strength wisdom clarity

Eddy handled these challenges by:

“At all times and under all circumstances, overcome evil with good. Know thyself, and God will supply the wisdom and the occasion for a victory over evil. Clad in the panoply of Love, human hatred cannot reach you” (Eddy, Science and Health, p. 571).

Establishing the Monitor - August 1908

Why:

- Press's reliance on sensationalism and disregard for truth
- Christian Scientists needed to be bolder in their involvement in the world.
- To be informed of the world's problems, healing those as well as their own.
- Not to explain the letter of Christian Science but to demonstrate its spirit.
- To give readers a new way of looking at the world, dedicated to the reform of thought and supported the Christian Science's insistence that God does not know or cause evil.

Eddy stated that the purpose of The Church is to “reinststate primitive Christianity and its lost element of healing” (Eddy, Miscellany, p. 17).



Evil



The Devil — not a personification of evil but “a lie; error; neither corporeality nor mind; the opposite of Truth; a belief in sin, sickness, and death” (Eddy, Science and Health, p, 584).

First biblical statement of evil was the serpent suggesting that there could be more than one God, Mind and that man, created from dust or matter, could become as gods.

God, good, omnipresent and omnipotent therefore there can be no other power named evil.

Destroy Evil

- with the “spiritual understanding that cast out evil as unreal” (Eddy, Science and Health, p.497).

- by understanding the nothingness of sin, sickness and death and the omnipresence and omnipotence of God.

- by exposing it. “You uncover sin, not in order to injure, but to bless the corporeal man” (Eddy, Science and Health, p. 453).

Jesus was tempted but refused to worship or give power to anything else but God

- recognised the power and authority of the Christ and was healed.
- detect it through the “dissecting of thoughts to discover their quality, quantity and origin” (Eddy, Science and Health, p. 462).

The continuing absence of some 20 newspaper correspondents in Cambodia,

presumably detained by pro-Sihanouk forces, poses serious moral issues for a journalist who has been released.

Why us? Are we precedent or exception? And if precedent, what kind of precedent?

These questions have haunted me since our release. So have others—questions about the nature of friendship and the trust of friendship, of freedom, of moral responsibility and moral ambiguity.

The three of us never said anything we did not believe, either in conversation or in the few statements that we were asked to write. Nor, I believe,

would we have. In that sense we were honest. Yet honest views offered fairly and honestly are two different things.

Perhaps I should specify what we did and did not do in detention.

Requests limited

It could be argued that we were asked for relatively little. We were asked to sign statements which were not ours. We were asked to write statements we had written

We lived, to some extent, the "other side".

Clearly, the Communists see the press as a means of winning goodwill and scoring points. Yet their action does strengthen a growing world conviction that the transmission of news is an obligation all its own.


